

- 1. Turn off vehicle and lock the brakes.
- 2. Locate the battery compartment. Remove the ground terminal, then the positive terminal to disconnect the battery cables.





Installation Instructions

Read all information included on page 1 before beginning operation or installation.

- 1. Remove the bumper from the UTV. There are two bolts to be removed at the bottom of the bumper and two bolts at the top of the bumper, one each behind the bumper's upright on either side of the grille.
- 2. Use a Torx wrench to remove the two screws at the front of the bumper securing the plastic grille.
- 3. Loosely secure the grille plate to the bumper using the Torx screws removed in Step 2.
- 4. Attach the roller fairlead to the grille and bumper assembly using the hardware included with the fairlead. Standard fairleads will not require the use of the fairlead adapter plate, however smaller fairleads will. If required, install the fairlead adapter plate to the grille before installing the fairlead.
- 5. Before installing the winch, be aware that winches with vertically oriented leads must be repositioned before installation. Loosen the cap screws to rotate the cap and reposition the leads into a 45° alignment or horizontal alignment.












6. Install the winch to the winch plate. There are three different configurations for mounting the winch shown below. Use these diagrams to determine the proper mounting position based on your winch's mounting pattern.

- Two-Hole Bolt Patten (3.100")(Fig. 4)
- Standard Bolt Pattern (3.00" x 4.875")(Fig. 5)
- Wide Bolt Pattern (3.00" x 6.60")(Fig. 6)





- 7. Place the winch mount assembly along the front of the UTV just underneath the radiator opening. Align the four mounting holes with the four matching holes in the UTV frame. Fasten the winch mount assembly to the frame using an M8 \times 1.5 \times 25mm hex head bolt secured by an M8 lock nut through each of the top two aligned holes. Pass the M10 \times 1.5 \times 25mm carriage bolts through the UTV frame then through the winch mount's bottom mounting holes. Secure each carriage bolt with an M10 lock nut.
- 8. Reinstall the front bumper using its original hardware.
- 9. Follow the winch manufacturer's recommendations for proper winch wiring procedures.
